2) Saturday, February 9 - \$8 until 3pm, **\$20 after 3pm.** No in / out privileges

3) Pre-purchase parking passes **WITH** your ticket order for \$8 + \$.50 fee (for the day) and are limited to availability.

4) Parking passes purchased separately from your ticket order are \$8 + \$.50 fee +\$5 per order.

5) The Rose Quarter parking lot will not be available for RV's, motor homes, or other overnight camping.

7. COLISEUM RULES: The coliseum does not allow signs, banners, balloons or “outside” food anywhere in the facility.

8. SERVICE ANIMALS: Trained guide dogs and service animals assisting guests are welcome at OSAA State Championships. All other animals are prohibited. All service animals must remain on a leash or in a harness, and be in full control of the handler, at all times. Handlers are responsible for any damage or injuries caused by their animals, must properly dispose of waste in appropriate containers and must take appropriate precautions to prevent property damage or injury.

9. LOST AND FOUND: During the event, Lost & Found will be at the OSAA Event Office or other location designated by the host facility / OSAA Staff. The Veterans Memorial Coliseum Guest Information Booth is located at Entry CC. The Guest Services staff will assist you with questions, wheelchair escorts, Assisted Listening Devices and Lost and Found inquiries during events. If you lose something during an event, stop by one of our information booths and fill out a Lost & Found form. Make sure to stop by after the event and double check if your item has been turned in. Lost and Found items may be picked up from the Facility Security department, Monday through Friday 9am to 4pm. 10. AWARDS: Trophies and medals will be presented at the conclusion of the morning and afternoon performances (refer to performance schedule).

- A. **Trophies:** Trophies will be presented to 50% of the teams in a division up to a maximum of five in each division.
- B. **Medals:** Individual medals will be presented to both the champion and second place teams in each division.
